

Announcement of a scholarship for the summer semester 2025

The **Theodor Laymann Foundation Fund** is awarding a scholarship to eligible students of the Master's program in Chemistry at the University of Bonn to financially secure the final phase of their studies for the summer semester of 2025. The scholarship will be awarded for a period of six months in the amount of EUR 735.00 per month to students whose studies are not secured by state funding.

The award is generally made after the successful completion of all compulsory modules with the exception of the advanced internship and three/two (PO14/20) elective modules in the master's degree program and thus the acquisition of at least 60 credit points for the time spent working on the master's thesis. For students on the master's degree program, an average grade is calculated across the modules of the master's degree program, which comprises 60 credit points. All compulsory modules must be passed and are included in the calculation of the average grade. The advanced internship is excluded. Only those applicants who have the grade in question set at least as "good" can be included in the group of those entitled.

All applicants will be selected based on social criteria, taking into account the income of parents and, if applicable, spouse. Please provide appropriate evidence of this.
