### 2. Collection and storage of personal data as well as type and purpose and their use

The documents and information you provide to us will be used exclusively to process your application or request and will be treated confidentially. For this purpose, they will be processed, used and stored electronically and, on a case-by-case basis, in another suitable form.

The data processing takes place due to the initiation or fulfillment of a contract pursuant to Art. 6 Paragraph 1 Clause 1 Letter b of GDPR.

The personal data collected from you will be deleted or blocked as soon as the purpose for which it was stored no longer applies. Storage may also take place if this is provided for by the European or national legislator in EU regulations, laws or other provisions to which the controller is subject. The data will also be blocked or deleted if a storage period prescribed by the aforementioned standards expires, unless there is a need to continue storing the data for the conclusion or fulfillment of a contract.

### 3. Transfer of data to third parties

Your personal data will only be transferred to third parties if this is necessary for the processing of your application or request. #### 4. Rights of the data subject

You have the right

- if you have given your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent to the data processing body at any time in accordance with Art. 7 Paragraph 3 GDPR. This means that the data processing based on this consent may no longer be continued in the future;
- in accordance with Art. 15 GDPR, information about your data from the data processing body processed personal data. In particular, you can request information about
  - the purposes of processing, - the category of personal data, - the categories of recipients to whom your data has been disclosed or become,
  - the planned storage period or, if specific information is not possible, Criteria for determining the storage period,
  - the existence of a right to rectification, erasure, restriction of processing or objection, - the existence of a right of appeal, - the origin of your data, unless it is provided by the data processing body were raised,
  - as well as about the possible existence of automated decision-making, including profiling, and, where appropriate, meaningful information about its details;
- to request the immediate rectification of inaccurate or completion of your personal data stored by the data processing body in accordance with Art. 16 GDPR;
- pursuant to Art. 17 GDPR, the deletion of your data stored by the data processing body stored personal data. This does not apply if
  - for processing for the exercise of the right to freedom of expression and **Information**,
  - to fulfill a legal obligation to which the controller is subject,
  - for reasons of public interest, - to assert, exercise or defend legal claims or
  - for archiving purposes in the public interest, scientific or historical research purposes or statistical purposes pursuant to Article 89, paragraph 1
